- As of February 09, 2023, Lenawee County had 30,602 positive cumulative cases:
 - o 54 total active cases
- Demand for the COVID vaccine has declined.

The end of the public health emergency has implications on subsidies for food resources and supplies in response to the pandemic. As the health department gets more information, it will be shared with the community and Lenawee Health Network.
