COVID-19:

- As of March 2023, Lenawee County had 30,842 positive cumulative cases:
 - o Increase to 79 total active cases
- *Monica Hunt – Lenawee County Health Department provided the following updates:*
 - o Reported that the COVID-19 national emergency and public health emergency declarations end on May 11th, 2023.

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- MDHHS continues to support testing operations and supplies. It is anticipated that near the end of 2023, communities will need to begin purchasing testing and vaccination supplies.
- Medicaid redeterminations are happening nearly simultaneously. It is estimated the redetermination will result in 400,000 residents will no longer be eligible across the state of Michigan.
