During off season they purchase fresh produce from Ciolino in Temperance but during the growing season they use local farmers and venders. The farm has some areas that are handicap assessable and there is a long walking path that winds through the area.

Some interesting information that Amy shared is that Canna bulbs are edible as are Jerusalem Artichokes. She also shared that when you are mulching, to be effective, the mulch should be 4-6" thick. Try not to use freshly created wood chips. If possible let them set as long as possible.

In the business meeting we discussed the results of the Trauma Temperature Check. We as a group scored higher then other groups. Under the fifth point of Empowerment our pantry's need to listen to our clients and give them a voice is selecting the food that they receive. We need to try to understand why some of our clients exhibit a negative attitude and make sure that we don't respond in kind.

There will be no meeting in July so our next meeting will be August 8. De'Angelo spoke about a community garden that has been started in the Erie St. area. So we will meet at The City of Refuge Church at 301 S. Tecumseh St. and then tour the garden.
