Collective Impact Core – Trauma & Resilience Common Agenda

- 11 LHN members submitted a temperature check survey to support the network in assessing its current state of being Trauma Aware -> Trauma Sensitive -> Trauma Responsive -> Trauma Informed.

CHIP Strategy & Collaborations

Agency Spotlight Presentation – The M-Society, Socorro Sevilla

- Socorro is the owner of Hilltop Counseling and The M-Society.
- Hilltop Counseling opened in 2014 in Hillsdale and expanded its operations to Adrian in 2017.
- In 2020, The M-Society was established to improve mental and physical well-being of members of the LGBTQIA+ community. This goal is met through supportive services that improve individual well-being and service projects that increase community involvement and engagement.
 - o About 82% of clients are LGBTQIA+ populations.
 - o About 89% are under age 25.
 - o 45% are gender expansive.
- The M-Society offers the following programs:
 - o Rainbow Connection – This is a peer-support and socialization group for LGBTQIA+ youth and allies, ages 11-18. This group is free, and no registration is required. Meets the last Tuesday of every month from 7-8 pm.
 - o Transgender Michigan – This is a peer-support group for Trans and GNC adults. This group is free, and no registration is required. This group meets the 3rd Thursday of every month, from 6-7 pm.
 - o Clothing Closet – M-Society maintains a stock of clothing in both masculine and feminine styles in a variety of sizes. Personal hygiene items are also available. Please contact to set up a time to shop or stop by during an event.
 - o Period Packs – Provides free menstrual products to help end period poverty. Contact M-Society for delivery during winter months. In collaboration with the All About Adrian Resident Coalition (A3).
